## Read Genesis 2:4-17

1. Why did God need to create Man? What makes Man special from the rest of creation?

(Ephesians 2:10) God's priority is not for us to go to Heaven. His Priority is for us to do the work that he has planned for us before we came into existence.

(1Corinthians 15:45) When Jesus rose from the dead he entered into a new form of existence. Just as Adam was formed from dirt, he assumed a new and glorified body to suit his new life. As believers in Christ Jesus we too will take on a new and glorified form when our work here on earth is through.

(Ephesians 2:24) We were created in Gods Image to live a Godly (God Like) life.
